Race Meeting – Friday/Saturday/Sunday, 25/26/27 July 2008

SPECIAL TERMS OF RACE ENTRY: (For the attention of each Race Series Coordinator)...

1. From 2008 the annual Silverstone Classic (Event) is presented, organised and promoted by Motion Works UK Limited (MWUK) on behalf of the new Event Licensee Classic Automotive Events Limited (CAE) and in the best interests of the Event, Silverstone Circuits Limited (SCL) and the British Racing Drivers' Club (BRDC).
2. The race element of the Event will be under the control of the Historic Sports Car Club (HSCC). However, the race commercial agreement will be between MWUK and each individual Race Series Coordinator.
3. All race titles are the property of the Event and MWUK/CAE.
4. All race paddocks to assemble during the Wednesday/Thursday with all paddocks complete for the 3-day event by Thursday PM. All paddocks to remain assembled with no race cars removed until 16:00hrs on Sunday.
5. All race entries to be coordinated by the individual Race Series Coordinators and submitted to the HSCC as per the terms of race Entry. Update entry lists of Driver & Co Driver names and car year/type/model to be forwarded to MWUK on a regular basis to assist with best possible PR, website and programme production.
6. All race fees are a fixed fee per race category as agreed by MWUK and each Race Series Coordinator. This will include:
 - 6.1. Opportunity for exclusive Event competitor testing at a special rate of £99 inc VAT per race car at a special Silverstone Classic Test/Media Day on **Wednesday 30 April***
 - 6.2. Opportunity for exclusive Event competitor testing at £199 inc VAT per race car on **Thursday 24 July***
 - 6.3. Official Practice/Qualifying on **Friday 25 July***
 - 6.4. Races as per the Event schedule on **Saturday 26 July*** and **Sunday 27 July***
 - 6.5. All payments will be made directly to MWUK and made payable to... "The Silverstone Classic"
7. Race Series Coordinators will be responsible for all:
 - 7.1. Team/driver liaison
 - 7.2. Regular updates of Race Entry lists to MWUK
 - 7.3. Personnel and Vehicle Pass distribution (as provided by HSCC at the Event Welcome Centre)
 - 7.4. Best possible paddock presentation (Best Paddock Award to be presented at the Event)
 - 7.5. Competitor logistics and any issues raised
8. A fixed package of benefits will be issued for all Entrants, as follows:
 - 8.1. Event 3-day Personnel Passes x 6 for one-driver cars and x 8 for two-driver cars
 - 8.2. Competitor Paddock Vehicle Pass x 1 per race car/transporter as required
 - 8.3. Competitor Private Car Park Pass x 1 for one-driver cars and x 2 for two-driver cars
 - 8.4. Passes to the exclusive "Drivers Club" x 4 for one-driver cars and x 8 for two-driver cars
 - 8.5. Event Welcome Pack x 1 per registered competitor, including: Welcome letter from the Promoters, Event Souvenir Programme and Event Souvenir.
9. Special Request from Event Organisation:
 - 9.1. In the interests of a successful event the organisers respectfully request all race coordinators to maintain, as close as possible, the following time schedule enabling drivers names/cars to be known early to generate the best possible pre-event media coverage.

W/c 07 Jan - Race coordinators to commence informing competitors via mail, email and at Autosport Show

W/c 04 Feb - Race entries open with 25% deposit of race entry fee due

W/c 26 May - Close of race entries with balance of race entry fee due
