

Formula 3 SWEBE E3 (Number 1) 1966 for sale.



This is a unique opportunity to buy the first ever built SWEBE Formula 3 from 1966 (copy of Brabham BT15 1965).

The SWEBE was designed and built by Ronnie Peterson's father Bengt Peterson and Sven "Bergvagg" Andersson. Only four SWEBE was build. This SWEBE No.1 was owned and drove by the Egert Haglund (Swedish) and he competed on most of the Swedish and Danish race circuits during 1966 to 1968. Egert Haglund was successful with the SWEBE E3 at that time.

Complete competition history, result and documentation from 1966 to 1968 come with the car.

The SWEBE Number one was completely overhauled and restored between 1985 and 1988. The SWEBE has only done two test runs after the restoration 1988.

The SWEBE are today equipped with a 1600cc Formula Ford Engine (Formula Ford), but the original Engine block "Screamer" (Down draft and serial number 9E6015B) and cylinder head comes with the car, as well the F3 magnesium wheels. The original gearbox (Hewland H6-984) is still on the car.

Please read more about SWEBE on the Ronnie Peterson's official home page, especially the biography section 1966. Ronnie Peterson was driving SWEBE number 4 at that time. Ronnie Peterson's brother Tommy Peterson has confirmed that this SWEBE is the original Number 1 with the right specifications.
